About LCB

Laksamana College of Business (LCB) was established in 2003 in partnership with the Kensington College of Business (KCB) in London, UK and Abdul Razak Holdings, Brunei Darussalam. At LCB students are able to study a variety of business and business related courses. One of our very popular programmes is the Academic Pathway, which is accredited by the Brunei Ministry of Education.

Through the Academic Pathway programme, students are able to take the University Foundation Course (UFC) and the BA Common Year 1 over a duration of two years at LCB. Once completed, students are able to continue their studies and complete a degree by studying for only a further two years in the United Kingdom. The BA Common Year 1 programme is recognised by many leading UK universities including The University of South Wales, Aberystwyth University, Keele University, and the well-known University College, Birmingham, amongst many other prominent UK universities.

However, not only is this a great opportunity to study in the UK available to Bruneian students, we have also extended this opportunity to international students, and mature students working in the private sector in Brunei. They are able to take advantage of this opening by completing one of our professional courses - the KCB Diploma in Business Management.

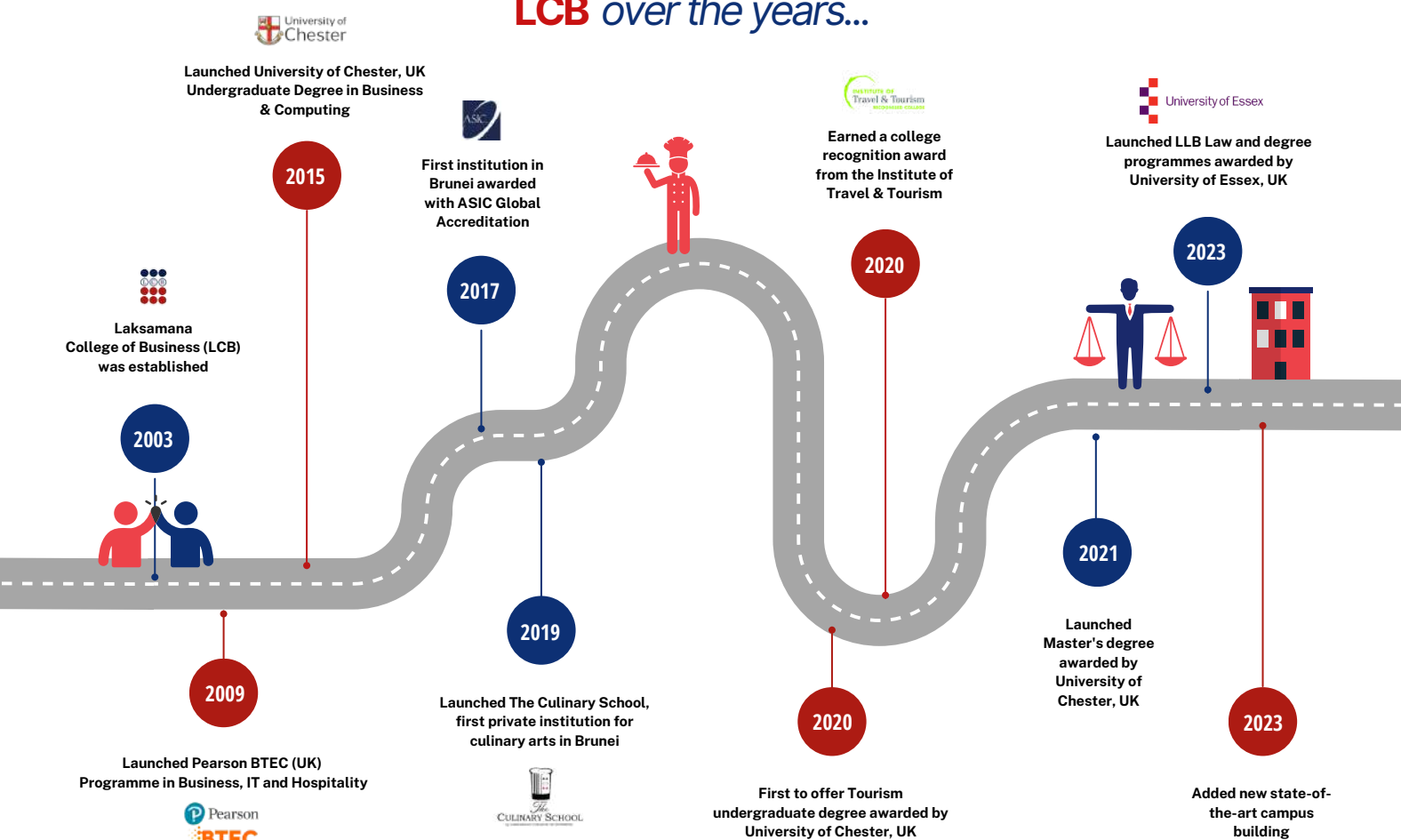
We at LCB are never satisfied and are always looking for ways in which we can meet our students' needs.

The College was established in 1982, and initially located at Kensington {hence the name}, as a result of the realisation that Business Management was not served by high-quality professional training courses in the same way as parallel professions such as Law and Accountancy had already been for many decades. This conviction has continued to shape the way the College works up to the present day.

The College sought out the best of the relevant external qualifications then available and offered its own complementary material and diplomas concurrently, but also constantly looked for opportunities for exposure to real-life corporate culture, positioning itself as a specialist business school providing training for the managers of the future.

The College was one of the very first independent colleges to be approved as a degree course provider by Act of Parliament originating from the UK Government's Department of Education. Over time the College has offered foundation degrees, Bachelor's degrees and Masters degrees with around a dozen UK Universities. It soon began including courses preparing for the traditional liberal profession of Law and Accountancy, which had been its model when it was founded, as well as in Computing. It is worth noting that throughout these developments, the College has continued to offer its own specialised diplomas and that these have not only enjoyed wide professional currency, but have been recognised for admission or advanced standing by around twenty UK universities.

It opens pathways at diploma level in IT, Hospitality and Business. Many of our level 2 students have gone on to complete full university degrees, both here at LCB and abroad.
